- Get staff talking about it

Abigail from disability 4 sport also mentioned the possibility of getting involved in school cluster meetings to raise the profile further and really drive forward the aim of breaking down negative perceptions about children with disabilities or educational needs. The plan will be produced by September 2015 and worked upon within the next academic year.
