We really were on a roll here so next up we discussed how to build confidence, motivation, and resilience in school. We heard about clubs helping young people to be themselves, booster lessons helping and going over the same lessons again can really help too. We will be sharing this bit of feedback with our employment teams.

Our final discussion was about the MSC video we are planning for the new academic year. As part of the plan for the video the group would like to see:

- How do we do it?
- Why do we do it?
- Capture the MSC meetings
- Get young people to talk about how they have overcome challenges
- Make sure people with autism and ADHD are included
- Use some sort of acronym throughout the film
- Make sure staff speak too
